The Juvenile Department is made up of the Juvenile Justice and Child Protection Divisions. The Juvenile Justice Division hears cases involving minors under the age of 18. The Child Protection Division hears cases involving child abuse and neglect and termination of parental rights.

Confidentiality

Juvenile court records are sealed and cannot be disclosed to the general public. The procedure for accessing confidential records is controlled by the Office of the Presiding Judge.

Expungements

If a juvenile court record is not eligible for automatic expungement under the Juvenile Court Act, a person can petition the court for expungement of juvenile court records. If the court orders the records expunged, the Clerk of the Circuit Court expunges the records and the records are treated as if they never occurred.

Juvenile Justice cases are heard in each of the District Courthouses on a weekly basis.
